

# MPSU Launches 'Pledge for a Renewable Province' at NSTP Environmental Seminar

Mountain Province State University (MPSU) has launched the "Pledge for a Renewable Province," using its platform to encourage a public-wide commitment to clean energy.

The new campaign was fittingly unveiled during the university's seminar, "Go Green, Stay Green: An Environmental Protection Response," held at the University Auditorium today, November 9, 2024. The event, organized by the National Service Training Program (NSTP) in collaboration with the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office – Mountain Province (PENRO-MP), was held in celebration of National Environmental Awareness Month.

In his message, MPSU President Dr. Edgar G. Cue, represented by Bontoc Campus Director Dr. Arel B. Sia-ed, stressed the importance of environmental sustainability. He specifically urged the NSTP students in attendance to become active advocates for a clean and green environment.

Building on that call to action, the university introduced the "Pledge for a Renewable Province." The campaign will see the university host events, gather petitions, and meet with local government and business leaders to promote a public pledge toward 100% renewable energy.

*"As an educational institution, we have a duty to lead the conversation,"* said President Cue in his message. "This campaign is our pledge to advocate for a future where Mountain Province is powered entirely by clean, renewable, and sustainable energy." The seminar featured expert insights from notable PENRO speakers,





including Ecosystems Management Specialist I Mr. Ralff Halley B. Marrero, EMS II/PEMU Mountain Province Ms. Maureen F. Menguria, and Records Officer Ms. Jenalyn G. Calawen, who were accompanied by Ms. Maybel B. Sacyaten, Ms. Karin Joy C. Ollos, and Ms. Flora Mae A. Apos.

The university confirmed that the same activity will be conducted on November 16, 2024, for the second batch of NSTP students.
